All C2 summer camps are for kids 7-12 years old.

WHEN

Camps will run Monday through Friday excluding statutory holidays (July 1st and Aug 5th).

Drop off: 8:00-9:00am

Pick up: 4:00-5:00pm

Parents/Guardians are required to sign in / sign out all campers in-person at drop off / pick up.

WHERE to Drop Off/Pick Up

Nova VIP Suite

- From Main Street, enter the RJ Arena doors (between the Genmec Hall [previously Agriplex] and Pontiacs doors. There is a noticeboard directly outside the doors and there will be a camp sign on the doors).
- The Nova VIP Suite is directly up the stairs and to the left.

CANCELLATION POLICY

The Bonnyville and District Centennial Centre reserves the right to assign the participant to a group most appropriate for their age and ability; to request any participant to withdraw from their camp if the participant is not acting in an appropriate and responsible manner; or to cancel any camp with 100% refund.

Cancellations will be given 100% refund if it has occurred two weeks prior to the start of camp. Cancellation with one weeks notice will result in a 50% refund. If the cancellation occurs with less than one week's notice, no refund will be issued.

I understand that this is a legal agreement. It is binding upon myself as well as upon my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, assigns, and legal representatives in the event of death or incapacity. **I have read and understood all of the terms of this agreement, and by signing this agreement voluntarily, I agree to abide to these terms.**

CLIMBING WALL WAIVER RELEASE AND INDEMNITY

1. _____ (Parent/Guardian) * I, the Undersigned, understand and acknowledge that I am aware of the risks associated with or related to the use of the climbing wall (including risk of severe or fatal injury), to myself; particulars of which include but are not limited to the following:
- a. Injuries resulting from falling and impacting climbing wall faces or the ground, including an object or objects resting on the floor;
 - b. Injuries resulting from activities such as climbing, belaying, rappelling, rescue systems, and other rope techniques;
 - c. Injuries resulting from falling climbers or objects such as rope or climbing hardware;
 - d. Injuries resulting from the physical activity of the sprot itself including but not limited to neck and back strains, muscle strains, muscle pulls, tendon & ligament damage, as well as other typical athletic injuries or more serious injuries.
- I voluntarily accept these physical risks.
2. _____ (Parent/Guardian) * I understand that by signing this document, I, my successors, heirs, assigns or personal representatives waive the right to sue or otherwise claim against the Bonnyville and District Centennial Centre, its employees, volunteers, officials, sponsors, directors, agents, coaches, instructors, or independent contractors for any loss or damage connected with any property loss or personal injury that I sustain while participating in or preparing for any program or activity of the Bonnyville and District Centennial Centre.

BEHAVIOUR AGREEMENT

Bonnyville & District Centennial Centre

We ask both the Camper and the Parent/Guardian to read the Behaviour Expectations together and acknowledge & accept the responsibility to meet these expectations.

C2 Summer Camp is a safe, caring community where individual differences are valued, where people are supported in reaching their goals and accomplishing challenges, and where everyone can have fun! Because creating such a community requires the commitment of all participants, we ask everyone to agree to the behaviour expectations listed below. At camp, we refer to them as "the 3 'R's":

I WILL SHOW RESPECT FOR OTHERS

- I will respect other people's ideas and values, even if they are different from my own.
- All of my actions and language will have a positive impact on others in camp.
- I understand that any behaviour that could harm (physically or emotionally) a camper or staff member, or which is disrespectful, is unacceptable at C2 Camp.

I WILL SHOW RESPECT FOR MYSELF

- I will make the most of learning opportunities at Camp by participating fully in camp activities, I will try new things, and have a positive attitude.
- I will not allow exclusive relationships (like those with friends from home or school) to prevent me from getting to know other people at camp, or from including others in activities.
- I will stay with my camp when moving around C2 and always ask a counsellor before leaving the group.

I WILL SHOW RESPECT FOR THE ENVIRONMENT AND C2 FACILITIES

- I will not bring my cellular phone, music player, video games, radio, or other electronics to camp, because they detract from enjoyment of and interaction with others and with the natural world.
- I will be sensitive to the environment. I will always clean up after myself.
- I will pick up litter, and not damage or remove anything from the environment or C2 premises.
- I will take care of C2 Camp's facilities, program supplies, toys, and equipment.

IF A CAMPER HAS DIFFICULTY ADHERING TO OUR BEHAVIOUR AGREEMENT, C2 STAFF WILL:

- Remind the camper of expected behaviour.
- Review the Behaviour Agreement above.
- Discuss with the camper ways that staff members can support the camper in making necessary behaviour improvements.
- If the pattern of behaviour continues, C2 Camp staff will work with the camper to set specific, appropriate behaviour goals and outline consequences for continued inappropriate/unsafe behaviour.
- If the pattern of behaviour continues, C2 Camp staff will involve the parents/guardians for suggestions to help improve behaviour.
- Continued inappropriate/unsafe behaviour after parent involvement or severely inappropriate/unsafe behaviour (such as physical or emotional violence, bullying, or possession of prohibited items) will result in immediate dismissal from camp and forfeiture of camp fees. The parent/guardian is responsible for picking up a dismissed camper immediately.
